The Need and Response

The challenges of those overcoming homelessness, domestic abuse, or poverty are numerous. New Life Furniture works hard to help these people overcome one of their burdens by providing furniture and beds at no charge. It is our belief that the furniture makes a house a home and benefits the families in tangible and intangible ways. A place for families to gather for meals together, a bed for a good night's sleep, and a couch to relax on after a long day of work create an environment families can be proud of and a base for them to tackle and overcome other obstacles. The items and the moral support provided by New Life Furniture give a sense of hope, pride, and ownership to the beneficiaries of our service as well as letting them know others truly do care about their well being.



About New Life Furniture

New Life Furniture started as a small, volunteer ministry in the summer of 2006 to help families moving from the Interfaith Hospitality Network homeless program to permanent housing. Furniture donations were stored in the garages and basements of volunteers. Pickups of donated furniture and deliveries to families were done by volunteers with their own vehicles.

Several homeless shelters and a domestic abuse shelter heard about these efforts and began asking for help for their clients. What



began as a small effort to help a few families quickly turned into full-time coordination of donations, deliveries, and the need for more storage space.

Since its inception, New Life Furniture has helped more than **2,743** households – **6,619** men, women, and children – get a new start in life by collecting and delivering more than **40,802** furniture items directly to the homes of families living in bare or sparsely furnished housing.

Welcome Home! Baskets




